

CHULA VISTA COMMUNITY COLLABORATIVE PARTNERS MEETING MINUTES September 10, 2019

1. Service Coordinator, Joe Buselt, welcomed all organizations and stated the introduction.

2. Re-entry Support and Services Family Health Centers of San Diego

Antonio Smith discussed supporting clients that were recently released from prison. They are able to assist for up to a year after they have come out and help them prepare for the future. They have a 70% success rate. https://www.fhcsd.org/services-and-programs/

3. National Partnership to Train CHWs/ Promotores in Patient Centered Outcomes Research

Azucena Lopez de Nava spoke about the work the Promotores are doing in a national level. Azucena works for the Chula Vista Community Collaborative and will represent them in Washington, DC at a conference. They work on maintaining relationships with the community and other outreach opportunities.

4. Linking Teens to Care through a Youth Driven Approach- San Ysidro Health

Sarah Vaughan spoke about their program through San Ysidro Health and their teen clinic. They will be accepting 10-12th graders to participate in the internship in April 2020. Students must live within 5 miles of the site. They are given a small stipend at the end of internship and teens are able to us credit towards school hours. The teen clinic is for youth 12-24 years of age that qualify through family pact to receive services. https://www.syhteenclinic.org/

5. Alliance for African Assistance

Julie Germain spoke about the Alliance for African Assistance. They are able to interpret over 200 languages through the Global Village program and are located in City Heights. They are a resettlement program and assist families in connecting to various services including health insurance and refugee status. http://alliance-for-africa.org/index.php

6. City of Chula Vista Office of Sustainability

Manuel Medrano presented on measures that the city is working on to make San Diego County sustainable. 30 million tons of food is thrown away every year. Industrial zones are a topic they are currently researching.
